Anticipatory Set Guiding Questions

- What do you think this is?
- What observations can you make that assure you that you have the right answer?
- When in your life have you seen or used this?
- What part of the plant is this? You are showing them the root of the plant. The stem is above the ground and so is the flower and the fruit (yes, sweetpotatoes do make seeds)
- What purpose do you think these parts of the plants have? Storage
 of nutrients and sugars and water, anchoring the plant into the
 ground, absorption of water and nutrients. That is why they are
 so big.
- Why do you think this is so much bigger than another root of a plant (like on lettuce or basil)? It anchors the plant and it stores food for the plant for later (sugar).
- Where do these parts of the plants usually grow? They grow underground in the soil.
- What is the best place to grow these plants? In the sandy soils of parts of NC (especially the eastern part of NC)
