Teacher: Sweet Potato Journal Directions

How to use:

Printing: There are options to printing your student sweet potato journals.

- (Recommended) You may print the slides two to a page, make sure you select pages 2-5 and omit the directions page. This will make the booklet for their journal smaller (only uses 2 sheets of paper).
- You may print them full page (uses four sheets of paper).

Provide each student or group of students a sweet potato journal.

- Students will cut down the middle, dotted line to create two half sheets. This journal is to encourage students to take notes and record important information about the parts of a sweet potato plant, how sweet potatoes grow, and the impact of living and non-living things for the growth of plants.
- Teacher/Volunteer/Student helper will then staple booklet pages of the Sweet Potato Journal.
- **Begin teaching lesson in Activity 1.** Students will need to place their journals in a safe place so they can use them later in other lessons.
- Note Pages can be used during observations made in Activity 5.
