

Teacher: Sweet Potato Journal Directions

How to use:

Printing: There are options to printing your student sweet potato journals.

- *(Recommended) You may print the slides two to a page, make sure you select pages 2-5 and omit the directions page. This will make the booklet for their journal smaller (only uses 2 sheets of paper).*
- *You may print them full page (uses four sheets of paper).*

Provide each student or group of students a sweet potato journal.

- **Students will cut down the middle, dotted line to create two half sheets.** *This journal is to encourage students to take notes and record important information about the parts of a sweet potato plant, how sweet potatoes grow, and the impact of living and non-living things for the growth of plants.*
- **Teacher/Volunteer/Student helper will then staple booklet pages of the Sweet Potato Journal.**
- **Begin teaching lesson in Activity 1.** *Students will need to place their journals in a safe place so they can use them later in other lessons.*
- **Note Pages – can be used during observations made in Activity 5.**
