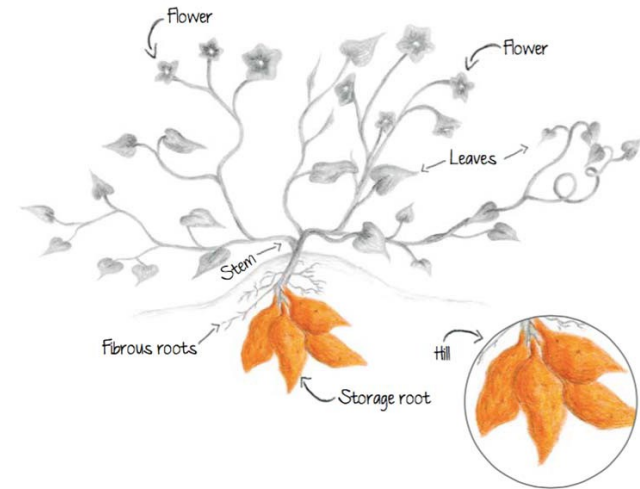

# Sweetpotato Words

Hill - a group of sweetpotatoes growing below the surface of the soil.

Leaves - part of the plant that uses energy from sunlight for photosynthesis.

Stem - the body or stalk of the plant.

Fibrous Root - thin, branching roots growing from the stem. Fibrous roots are shallow roots that collect water for plant growth.

Storage Root - roots that are specifically modified for storage of starch, water, and nutrients. Examples of storage roots are carrots and sweetpotatoes.

# Sweetpotato Words

Node - part of a plant stem where one or more leaves will emerge.

Slip - shoots that are grown from a mature sweetpotato.
